What does transition mean?



Starting school for the first time or changing from one phase of education to another.

 from primary [Key Stage 2] to secondary school [Key Stage 3]

or

• from secondary school to post-16 college or training.

Looking at schools

- Open evenings will take place in mainstream and special schools in September and October 2022 - parents will have an opportunity to speak to staff
- You will not be able to have a meeting about your child at the open evening and can contact the school after the open evening if you want to speak to staff in more detail
- See dates of Open Evenings available on the Enfield Schools Admissions website
- Check Special Schools' and Settings' websites for information on dates when parents can visit and how you can find out more information about the school

Applying for a secondary school place

When applying for a secondary school for your child, there are two different processes:

One process is managed by the Enfield Schools Admissions Service, and the other process is managed by Enfield SEN Services

2 Different Application Processes: Process 1

If your child does not have an Education, Health and Care Plan:

- Admissions process is co-ordinated by the LA School Admissions team
- You can express a preference for up to 6 schools
- Requests for out borough schools are made on the Enfield admissions form
- Check the Enfield schools guide for key dates and to see if you need to complete a *supplementary form* for the school
- Guidance on e-admissions process is on the Enfield admissions website

The application is completed online by the 31st of October 2022

Process 1: Allocation of school places

- You will receive one offer of one school place, regardless of the number of schools you have asked your child to be considered for
- National Offer Day is 1st March 2023
- If you have not been offered a place at a school of your preference, or you would prefer your child to attend an alternative school, information on next steps will be available on the Enfield admissions website.
- Your child's name will automatically be included on the waiting list for any Enfield school that was ranked as a *higher preference* than the school allocated

Education Health and Care Plan Process 2:

If your child has an EHCP:

Transfer is co-ordinated by the SEN team at Enfield Council:

- SEN Services writes to parents to request name(s) of school preferences parents can name a special school as a preference
- In addition to your preferences, SEN Services may also consult with your local secondary school
- The preference form is returned to SEN Services by **14th of October 2022**

Process 2: Naming a school on EHCP

- Annual Review of EHCP will be held in summer term of Y5 or early Autumn term in Y6
- Visit schools in September/October and meet the Inclusion teams
- SEN Services will write to parents between September and October and parents send the name(s) of preferred school(s) to SEN by October 14th 2022
- SEN Services will consult with your preferred school(s) and your local secondary school, if necessary
- Your child's EHCP will be finalised with name of the secondary school by 15th February 2023

Information on schools...

- Look at the Enfield Local Offer for the most up to date information
- School websites read the SEND Information Report for each school you are interested in
- Read Ofsted reports, bulletins and newsletters sent to parents, to get an idea of activities, after-school clubs and events at the school
- Talk to other parents but remember what works for one child might not be suitable for another child

Speak to your primary school

Your child's Year 6 teacher and the Senco will be able to answer many of your questions

- How will the transition to secondary school be planned for your child?
- Will the primary school meet with secondary school staff to plan the transition, so that the new school has all the information they need to support your child?
- Some secondary schools may allow children to visit during the summer holidays when the school is quiet check on the secondary school websites for information on transition to Y7 or speak to the school
- When will year 6 children have opportunities to visit the new school?

Does your child have a pupil passport/one page profile which could be shared with the secondary school/ you could suggest this to the primary school?

Contact schools to discuss your child...

- Call the secondary school(s)/special schools/settings you are interested in, and ask to speak to the special educational needs co-ordinator (SENCO) or the admissions department at the school
- You could send an email to the SENCO/school and ask if you can arrange a telephone/face to face meeting
- Read the school's SEND Information Report/Inclusion policy and this will help you to prepare for conversations with schools
- Read your child's professional reports and his/her EHCP, so you are clear about what specific questions you want to ask
