TalkACTivity

3 parent workshops and 7 child focussed sessions with Early Intervention staff . 4 programs per year in 5 settings. Progress tracked on EIPOF .



More than words

13 week program 3 times a year. Over the last 12 months 56 families have attended . 65% of children had progressed to the next stage of communication by the end of the course. 6 month following the completion :100% of children have progressed to a higher communication stage.

- **UPCAT – Universal Play and Communication Assessment and Advice Tool.**

(A new initiative for Private, Voluntary & Independent Pre-Schools & nurseries)

- Practitioners are reporting
- Quick and easy assessment
- Applying the aims to the child's learning journal
- Using the 6 week reviews to gather evidence for statutory needs assessment
- Using the tool to review all new children joining our setting
- The tool is used as part of the child's 2 year developmental review.

Secondary School – What’s it all about?

Launch Sept 2019

An interactive on line resource in production to support Yr 6 Autistic YP going through transition to independently access strategies to support anxiety and commonly identified concerns. The content has been produced by Autistic peers

Autism Peer Enablement

17x Year 6 and 6x Year 10 over the last 2 years

Yr6 Autistic students facilitated by Year 10 peers to support successful secondary school transition . 95% rated meeting older peers as a benefit and 80% parents report marked progress in confidence and use of conflict resolution strategies

Year 10 students developed work experience skills , coaching for interview and obtain a written reference

What students said “I like everything” “I enjoyed EVERYTHING”

Students rated as 100% when asked “would you recommend the group to a friend”

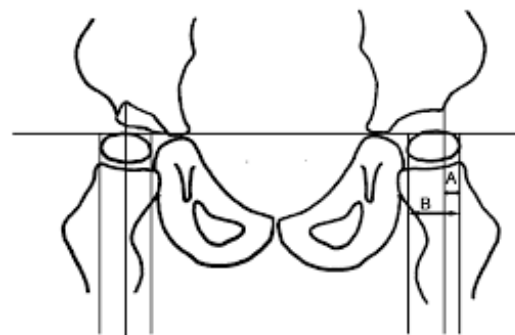
- **Transition to Reception groups**

78 children have attended . Interventions are held in a Mainstream school setting. Children with social communication disorders who are due to start mainstream primary schools. Intensive groups facilitated over the summer holidays with a Learning Consultant and the National Autistic Society. TAs are invited to attend and offered a workshop.

- **Bear Necessities** An inter-agency, multidisciplinary 6 week programme, focused on weight management with children/young people who are over weight aged 9-19years (N=9) and their families is currently delivered across all special schools. At 6 weeks, the anthropometric Measures show 75% losing or maintaining weight. Groups will now be co facilitated with IAPT and a tracking system including early warning is being developed with parents /schools .

Hip Surveillance

- Standardised surveillance for children who have Cerebral Palsy that will help to identify musculoskeletal problems early
- Surveillance runs between 2 and 16 years
- Regular physical and radiological examinations to enable effective management of these musculoskeletal changes during childhood



New Joint OT & PT Motor Co-Ordination Clinic

- Joint Occupational Therapy & Physiotherapy assessment.
- New joint care pathway: including motor skills group, football club and individual sessions if appropriate.
- Collaborative working with Tottenham Hotspurs Foundation & Enfield Town Football Club to develop New Motor Coordination Football club.
