Education Health Care Plans and Annual reviews (11 am to 12.30 pm)

This workshop will be led by Fazilla Amide of Our Voice and Zulkifl Ahmed SEN Services Manager and will look at Education Health Care Plans and Annual Reviews. We will be looking at:

- o A brief overview of the EHCP and Annual Review Process
- o Top Tips for Completing the 'All about Me' section of the EHCP
- What a good outcome should look like based on your child's aspirations.

What support should mainstream schools provide at SEN support? (11 am to 12 pm)

This workshop will be led by Smeeta Modasia, SEN Advisor, SEN Service and members of the Our Voice team. It will look at what support you should expect mainstream schools to provide for your child with additional needs, if they don't currently have an Education Health Care Plan in place. There will be an opportunity to look at parts of the 'Ordinarily Available Provision' document for schools and how this may help you in discussions with your child's school about appropriate strategies and adaptations that will support your child.

At the same time, we will be offering the opportunity for parents to request One-to-one sessions - 15-minute individual discussions with one of the team leaders from the SEN Services team, to give you the opportunity to discuss specific issues relating to your child.
